



Open Campus Lunch





Student Handbook Wording



Jersey Community High School has a closed campus except for the period of time a student is assigned lunch. A student may be assigned closed campus for his/her lunch period by an administrator or by parent request. Students are not permitted to leave campus at any other time unless permission is first obtained in the office. All students leaving the building must first sign-out. All 8th grade students will have closed campus AT ALL TIMES.



Open Campus Goals



Goal

- Utilize Open Campus Lunch to Increase Student Achievement by:
 - Encouraging all students to perform successfully in the classroom.
 - Encouraging all students to attend school on a regular basis.
 - Encouraging all students to make appropriate behavior decisions.



Criteria



The following criteria will be used in order for 9th through 12th grade students to have the privilege of leaving campus for lunch.

1. Passing or Pass all courses.
2. No unexcused periods or unexcused days absent.
3. Three (3) or more tardies per selected period of time.
 - a. Current tardy policy will not change. Four (4) tardies per class per semester will result in behavior consequence.
4. No behavioral referrals that lead to discipline consequences in the selected time frame.
 - a. Detention (After School, Lunch, Morning), ISD, and OSS.

Special Note:

- The first grade check at the start of a new school year will be the end of the 1st quarter. However, students that begin the year without Open Campus, will have their grades checked at the 1st quarter mid-term.



Timeframe



The following criteria will be used in order for 9th through 12th grade students to have the privilege of leaving campus for lunch.

This will not begin until the start of the 2018-2019 school year.

- Academic grades are ongoing (cumulative) and are based on the semester grade.
 - Checked at each midterm.
- Absences and behavior will be checked at each mid-term/end of quarter.
 - Checked at the conclusion of each midterm and quarter.
 - 1st Qt. Midterm, 1st Qt., 2nd Qt. Midterm, 2nd Qt. (Semester 1), 3rd Qt. Midterm, 3rd Qt., 4th Qt. Midterm, 4th Qt. (Semester 2)
 - Absences and behavior will then be reset.

Current JCHS 8th grade students will be held to the same standards as our 9th through 12th grade students for the start of the 18-19 school year.

Second semester grades and the last midterm of 4th quarter behavior and attendance will determine open campus eligibility at the start of the 18-19 school year.



Timeframe Continued



Students who meet one of the criteria will lose open campus after the next grade, attendance, and discipline check.

Example:

Student A has an unexcused absence during the first midterm of the second quarter. They would lose open campus during the second midterm/half of the second quarter. The same result would occur if the student had a discipline consequence or an “F” in any of their classes.

Note:

Coming back late from lunch will still result in a loss of open campus privileges as outlined currently in the Student Handbook.



Additional Notes



JCHS is currently working on the master schedule for next year.

JCHS is will provide the faculty with a list of students who have and/or do not have Open Campus privileges.

All policies in the Student Handbook will still be enforced.

Failure to follow the guidelines will result in additional consequences including an additional term of the loss of open campus.

Review of Criteria

- Academic grades are ongoing and are based on the semester grade.
 - Grades are checked at the conclusion of each mid-term, quarter, and semester.
 - Absences and behavior will be checked at each mid-term/end of quarter.
1. Passing or Pass all academic courses.
 2. No unexcused periods or unexcused days absent.
 3. Three (3) or more tardies per selected period of time.
 - a. Current tardy policy will not change. Four (4) tardies per class per semester will result in behavior consequence.
 4. No behavioral referrals that lead to consequences in the selected time frame.
 - a. Detention (After School, Lunch, Morning), ISD, and OSS.
